Laxmi was very sick there was no improvement in her health that's when the new doctor asked for various tests and confirmed that Laxmi has a low RBC count and this is because of the inherited condition from both the parents. She suffers from Sickle cell anemia.

The New doctor referred Laxmi & Parvati to TSCS, where free blood and free transfusion helps her a lot. There is a lot of improvement on the health condition of Laxmi.


