Malik was born in a small town in Nizamabad Telangana where treatments for any disease were very limited. Parents noticed that Malik's face was pale when he was around 4 months old and they took him to the local hospital, but they found nothing and situation started worsening. They had to bring Malik to Nilofer Hospital in Hyderabad, where they found out that he had thalassemia and needed blood transfusions.

With thalassemia diagnosis, comes a life-time of blood transfusions, hospital visits, doctors' appointments, and medications. It was told that Malik's life would be dependent on blood transfusions and the only cure was bone marrow transplantation else he has to live on frequent blood transfusions.

Living with thalassemia comes with a lot of challenges, but it does not mean that you have to let it control what you do. Thriving with Thalassemia means that you do not let your diagnosis stop you from achieving your dreams.

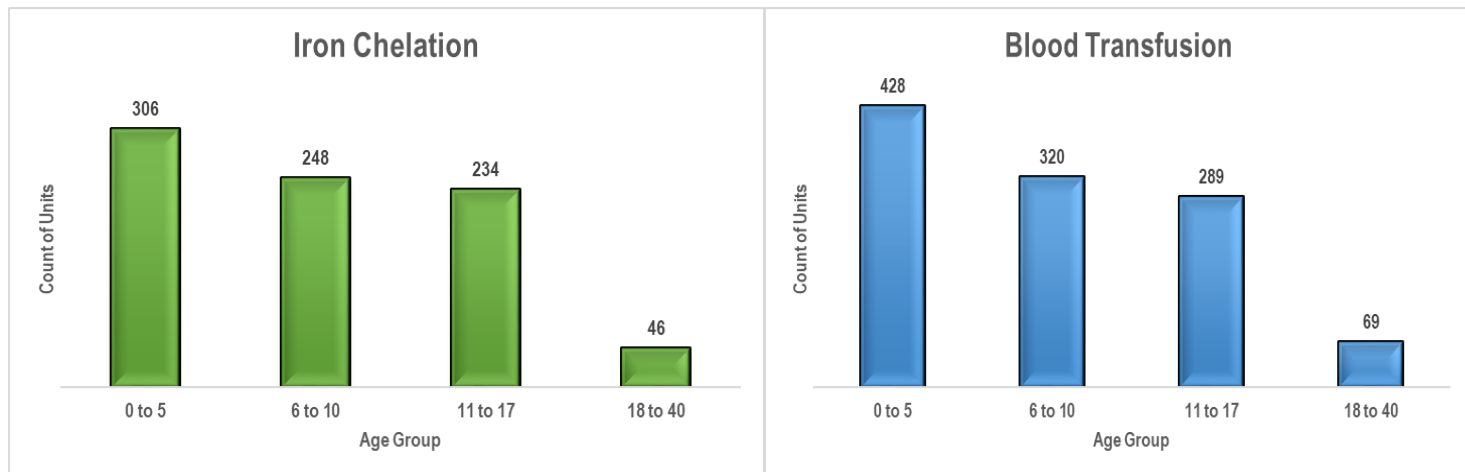
